**Don started by talking about the Respiratory Protection 1910.134. Gave a handout on the Why's /Requirements/Voluntary Steps/Voluntary use of filtering face pieces/Tools/Training/Respiratory Selection Matrix etc..**

**Eric started his presentation by MRSA means Methiculli Resistant Staphylococcus Aurous It's a bacteria. Antibiotics do work unlike virus and flu. Common cause of infection in community. Increasingly important cause of healthcare association infections since 1970's. the 1990's emerged again as a cause of infection in community. Resistant too many antibiotics. It is transmitted by direct contact susceptible to common disinfectants. MRSA is NOT a SUPERBUG! MRSA is more infectious than regular s.aureus. MRSA is a treatment problem. Patient education is critical. Infection-Fever, purulent drainage, loss of appetite. Outbreaks-Often first detected as clusters of abscesses or "Spider Bites". Various settings-Sports participants, Inmates, Military, Daycare etc..**

## **SAFETY DAY**

### **2007-2008 Leadership Institute Class**

Bob Whitman, Director of the Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Institute, praised not only the student committee who was responsible for Fire Safety Day but also the Fire Departments and EMS who were involved. "It was one of the more informative and unique days in the four years we have been doing the "Institute" Whitman said.

Spearheaded by Allen Township Fire Chief, Rod Goddard, assisted by Fire Chiefs and Fire Fighters from Allen Township, City of Marysville, Northern Union County Joint Fire and EMS Districts, Union County Joint Fire District, Union County EMS, Pleasant Valley Joint Fire District and Jerome Township Fire Departments, the class completed Firefighting Awareness 101.

The day began at 7:30a.m. Twenty-four class members were outfitted with fire fighting gear and oxygen tanks. They were broken down into five groups of five individuals. Each group preformed:

1. Aerial Ladder and Ground Ladder Skills.
  - To feel the flow of water (on the ground) and to stand in a bucket 8-10 stories off the ground was an experience.
2. Search & Rescue Tower
  - Students learned the use of buddy system, use of hose line in conducting a search in smoke filled 2-story building was a challenge.
3. Auto Extraction
  - Students learned the proper use of rescue tools and proper techniques on extricating victims. The class enjoyed cutting up or tearing apart 3 cars.
4. EMS
  - The class viewed operations of all volunteer Union County Management Agencies Operations Division. Students learned not only about the levels of EMS services, but also the critical decision making that goes into responding and treating victims.
5. Administrative Duties
  - The class learned about the operation from Chief to fire recruit, need to cooperate with all forum of government and rules and regulations.
6. Fire Investigation ~ Criminal Litigation Process by Keith Watson
  - The objective was to understand basic procedures of a fire prevention inspection program along with investigative techniques and arson related cases.
7. Law Enforcement and Communications Division
  - The objective was to inform the class of the duties and responsibilities of law enforcement as it relates to safety, PSO program and the 911 Communication Center.

After a nine hour day, The Leadership Institute class left with a much better understanding and appreciation for our Fire, EMS Personnel and County, City and Village Law Enforcement and Communications Division (911).
